With anticipation, our season is just around the corner. I am happy to welcome you all back, 200 + members, for another fun filled and busy season. Our annual events to look forward to include our Open House on May 11th, our Opening Day on May 20th (Members Only), the National Bowls Day on June 1st (Open House), and our always popular and indemand Wednesday Night Rec League in June & July. As you might heard in the surprising news, the beautiful and historic Buena Vista Park, where our club has been located since 1938, is undergoing a Park Upgrade and Maintenance starting approximately May 1st. Saskatoon was one of six major cities to receive funding of up to \$20 million from Canada's Natural Infrastructure Fund. The BV Park was one of several parks in Saskatoon to benefit from the fund. The upgrades for the BV Park include: upgraded pathways, upgraded irrigation (including the NLBC), updated site furniture (including lights), and enhanced plantings throughout the park (including trees). The estimated completion of the upgrades and maintenance by September. The BV Park will be closed during the planned upgrades, however, our club will remain open till August 31st. On Sept 1st we will be closed in order for our club to receive our long anticipated full irrigation replacement.

I am always reminded that the sport of lawn bowls is a sport for all ages, and all level of fitness where someone who nine years of age and can bowl against someone who 90 years of age regardless of identity. Please join us this year, and invite your friends and family for some fun and entertaining activities.
